

Santa Barbara Connect Home Project

2 YEAR IMPACT REPORT

Santa Barbara Connect Home is a partnership of the City of Santa Barbara, City Net, Cottage Health, and Santa Barbara Restorative Police. The program was made possible by a \$2 million grant from the California Homeless Emergency Aid Program (HEAP), which funded the program between April 2019-June 2021. The Connect Home program has partnered with the Housing Authority of the City of Santa Barbara, People Assisting the Homeless (PATH), Santa Barbara Fire Department, and the American Medical Response, to help prioritize clients and facilitate Rental Assistance Vouchers and shelter beds for this program.
